## 2020 Graduation Ceremony Location

Our graduation ceremony will take place on **June 4th, 2020** at The Historic Elsinore Theatre auditorium. The ceremony will begin at 7:00 pm. This will be a ticketed event. **Each and every guest** attending, no matter their age, will need a ticket to attend. The number of tickets per family will be determined in May, closer to graduation. **Graduation Rehearsal** will take place on the same day, **June 4th, 2020** from 9:30 am-11:30 am at the Elsinore Theatre auditorium. This is a **requirement** for walking in the graduation ceremony. ## Graduation Activities

### Senior Breakfast

You may bring an additional guest to the Senior Breakfast. The tickets are \$7.50 each and **must** be paid for in advance by **May 31st.**

Graduation week will have other fun activities for you to attend. Beginning at 8:00 am on June 3rd, there will be a Senior Breakfast for you and 1 guest. This event will also include the ECHS/TPP/Baker staff. **Please no young children.** This is a catered event for you and the guest of your choice. If you have childcare here at school, childcare will be available starting at 8:00 am.

Following the breakfast, there will be a Senior Assembly and you get to **wear your cap and gown!** More information about these scheduled activities will be communicated to you at a later date. These activities will go from approx. 8:00 am-11:00 am, the day before graduation. At 6:00 pm, on the 4th of June you will be required to report to The Elsinore Theatre to check in for graduation. The doors will be open for your guests at 6:30 pm, with graduation beginning at 7:00 pm at The Elsinore Theatre.

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## Student Fees and Credits

Students expecting to pick up their diploma at graduation must have all their fees paid by the morning of June 4<sup>th</sup>. Fees can be paid to the school at which they incurred or to ECHS/TPP/Baker. If you are unsure if you have fees to pay or where to pay those fees, please see Mrs. Garibay in the Main Office in Room 109. It is also important for seniors to understand that they must have **earned ALL of their required credits and required Essential Skills in order to walk at graduation**. ## Cap and Gown Orders

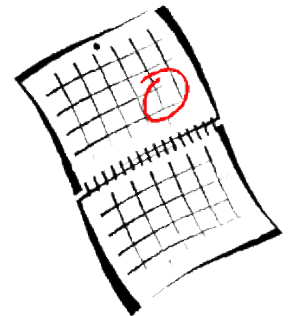
In order to guarantee that your graduation materials arrive on time, your **cap and gown order form** and payment must be received by Tami Walter in the main

office by **March 19th**. **A graduation package order form has been included with this newsletter.**

Please see the attached order form for pricing. Most packages include: cap and gown in black, our 2020 tassel in black and purple, 20 announcements with envelopes, tickets to the graduation ceremony, and tickets to the senior breakfast on June 3rd for you and one guest. If you choose a grad package that includes our yearbook, we will need your payment by **February 19th**. \*\*If you are obtaining a degree from Chemeketa Community College as well, please note, you **are** allowed to wear your black Cap and Gown for the CCC graduation ceremony also.

## College Applications and Scholarships

If you are planning on attending college after you graduate, remember to check on financial aid deadlines for the school that you are interested in attending, start working on your college application, and apply for FAFSA, if needed. This also includes scholarships. For example, Chemeketa Scholarship applications are due by February 29th for the 2020-2021 school year! Practice placement tests are found online through CIS, if you would like to check it out. Sarah Muir, Mrs. Tiscornia or Ms. Van Dreal would be happy to assist you. They are located in Room 125.



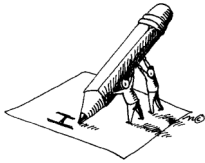
## Contact Information/Address Changes

## Essential Skills/Graduation Requirements

Earning all of your credits for graduation is not the only requirement for graduation.



In addition to course credits, you must also pass the reading, writing AND math essential skills. Passing these Essential Skills can be accomplished by passing Smarter Balance or by passing the appropriate work samples.

**Even if you receive all of your credits for graduation, you will not graduate until you have passed the additional requirements that apply to you.**

If you are not 100% sure, check with your counselor right away!
